

Graduate School Application Directions for the Human Rights Certificate

Application Fee Waiver Instructions

- You do not have to pay to apply for the Human Rights Certificate. After you have completed your application, please call the Graduate School and ask to speak to **Shirley Fiasconaro: (860) 486-3617**. Alternatively, email the grad school at: **gradadmissions@uconn.edu**.

- Explain that you are completing your application for the Human Rights Certificate; the Grad School staff will locate your file and waive your fee.
- After your fee has been waived, log back in and submit your application.

Enrollment Acceptance

- Once you receive notice that your application has been approved, you are not quite done.
- Please log back into the online application. Once you have, you must click “Enrollment Acceptance” to finalize your entry into the Human Rights Certificate.
- Note for international students: after you have accepted your enrollment for the certificate, please be sure to contact ISSS to update your DS2019 or I20.
